The newly-built University Academy Keighley (UAK) and Beechcliffe Special School on Greenhead Road in Keighley now boast a range of fantastic sports facilities that have resulted from huge investment of money, effort and energy by education, academic and sports and community partners.

UAK now represents a fabulous opportunity, with a unique mix of indoor and outdoor facilities and especially leading up to London 2012 and its Olympic and Paralympic legacy, to establish a centre of excellence for sport and disability sport for the district, the region and indeed nationally and beyond. Plans are already in hand to deliver a range of sports, education and technology services and activities for the whole community.

Although work at the site is ongoing, the athletics track and 3G pitches were opened earlier in May 2011, with the track being dedicated to the late John Woodcock, who worked as an athletics coach and development officer at this site and across Bradford for many years and who produced several great athletes and helped many people develop their potential, not just in sport but in life.
