

We meet on the first and third Sunday of the month and on a Wednesday in the summer. The walks are led by an experienced leader and can vary from about 6 miles to around 10 miles and anywhere in between. The first walk of the month tends to be a shorter one to let people who may not have walked for a while get back into it. We are a friendly collection of people and welcome new walkers. The first of the seasons broad beans and peas are available now. I look forward tothem making an appearance so I can cook this. A meal in itself if served with bread and cheese. You can substitute the butter for olive oil in the recipe if you want to go vegan.

Ingredients (feeds 4)

2 medium courgettes, peeled & cut into chunks

I medium cucumber, peeled & cut into chunks

Ilb fresh peas in their pods, podded with pods reserved

2 pints of vegetable stock

2lb fresh broad beans in their pods, podded I lb new potatoes (Cornish are ideal), scraped or peeled and cut into chunks

L cos lettuce

I bunch spring onions

Sea salt & freshly ground black pepper I heaped tablespoon freshly chopped mint Cider vinegar

Method

Heat your vegetable stock, sort your pea pods, discarding any manky ones, roughly chop them and chuck them in your stock, bring to the boil and leave to simmer, lid off for 15 to 20 minutes.

In a large pot, melt your butter over a low heat and add the chunks of courgette and cucumber. Cook slowly until soft but be careful not to allow them to take any colour.

Once soft, strain your stock into the pot with the cucumber and courgette and chuck the pods in the compost heap. Add the peas, beans and potatoes and bring to a gentle simmer for 20 minutes. Meanwhile, remove all the outer dark green leaves from your lettuce and shed the remaining heart of paler leaves. Trim and finely chop the whites of the spring onions. Once its 20 minutes are up, remove your soup from the heat, season to taste with salt and freshly ground black pepper and add your lettuce and spring onions, stir well, cover and leave to cool for 10 minutes. Ladle into bowls and drizzle a teaspoon or so of cider vinegar over each serving.







Have you got an item of clothing that means something special to you? Maybe your beautiful wedding dress, your reliable dressing gown, or

your grandad's fishing hat? Clothes hold so many memories, and we want to hear about them for our forthcoming artistic installation, a new commission from Bingley artist Hannah Lamb. Her work 'Fragment of a Dress' will complement the current 'Defying Expectations' exhibition, and is inspired by the costumes of Charlotte Brontë and your wardrobe! Hannah Lamb is a visual artist, lecturer and author, working in the field of art textiles. Fascinated by textiles, clothing and the stories they can tell, her practice is a personal dialogue with materials. Experimenting with layers of imagery and surface; print, stitch and construction techniques are carefully combined to create both sculptural installation works and smaller, more intimate pieces. She has a fascination with our shared material heritage. A tiny scrap of cloth can open up a myriad of stories, from the personal to the

Textiles and clothing can hold powerful memories, reminding us of people, places and special moments in our lives. Today, despite living in world of 'fast-

fashion' and disposable attitudes to clothing, many of us still keep hold of things that help us remember people, places and moments in time. Hannah's work is all about collecting these memories and moments from our visitors and community members. From 7 -19 June, you are invited to contribute your own story about an item of clothing that means something special to you.

Perhaps you'd like to tell us about a favourite party dress, a treasured family heirloom or your 'lucky' football scarf. Come along to the Brontë Parsonage Museum where you will find our 'Washing Line of Memories' in the foyer; it is here that you can share a memory or your thoughts and become part of our new artist installation.

Hannah will be constructing a ghostly dress made from silk organza, onto which, with the help of students from Bradford School of Art, she will embroider personal stories about our clothes and what they mean to us. The finished dress will be on show in the Servant's Room from late July until the end of December.

The Museum is open 10am -5pm, Wednesday to Sunday. Join us at the beginning of June for a special opportunity to become part of Hannah's work, and see your memories exhibited in the Museum.


