

Students from Keighley College have achieved six manufacturing industry accolades as part of the Milner Awards.

recognise the achievements of first year
apprentices on the Advanced Manufacturing
and Engineering (AME) programme at the
college.

Three apprentices have been selected to receive the main awards: Outstanding Apprentice, Academic Achievement and Skills Achievement, and have been given a cash prize in recognition of their accomplishments. Three additional students have received special recognition awards.

William Jowitt, director of Keighley Training Consortium and member of the supervisory board of the AME, said: "Apprentices are one of the key engines of economic growth; each year we see ambitious learners strive for excellence through the AME programme.

Ben Bott, who won the Outstanding Apprentice Award, added: "I feel incredibly proud to receive such a prestigious award. My mechanical engineering apprenticeship at Produmax has been a pivotal point in my learning and development, equipping me with the technical skills needed to flourish in my career. 



t's great to see and hear steam trains back in the Valley. Since the shed doors were forced to close back in March 2020, We (The Keighley and Worth Valley Railway) have had several false dawns, with a reopening in August, then early December and again in April of this year. We do hope that the government's roadmap is as one way as they've suggested and that we can now focus on the future.

As lockdown eases, we are able to offer a more flexible service rather than the pre-booked compartment operation that we have run so successfully during the periods of the most stringent restrictions. As this flexibility returns, we hope shortly to be able to offer once again our **Members'** and Local Residents' concessions. Please check the website for the latest details and timetable as we adapt the service to ensure we continue to comply with the latest guidance.

We can now also plan for the rest of the year, and are looking forward to the reintroduction of our Haworth **Haddock** fish and chip supper services; trains that make use of our exquisite luxury Pullman carriages, including cream tea, Prosecco tasting as well as full dining services: and we hope to be able to re-introduce our much-loved on train catering services shortly (we might have to stick with bottled real ale to begin with, but fingers crossed that normal real-ale bar service can resume on board shortly!) To be able to talk so positively about the future is thanks to the fantastic support that the Railway has received since the first lockdown was announced. We have had hundreds of thousands of pounds n donations, for which we will be eternally grateful, and a number of significant grants from the National Heritage Lottery Fund, representing funding from central government, as well as grants from BDMC and a number of other sources, including the KWVR charitable trust. We have also benefitted from the hundreds of volunteers who have continued to give so much of their time to the Railway during the periods of lockdown that has prepared us for the three reopenings in the last few months. WELCOME BACK to the BRONTË PARSONAGE MUSEUM

By the time this lands on your doormat, the Parsonage will have been welcoming back visitors for a number of weeks and maybe some of you will have already been along. If not, read on to see what you can expect.

lust like last summer, admission continues to be by pre-booked timed ticket only even for those who live nearby! Those of you familiar with the Museum will know that it is an intimate, historic building with our collections displayed in a number of small rooms. It's therefore very important that we control numbers and facilitate social distancing. All visitors over the age of 16 will need to provide full contact details in line with NHS Test and Trace requirements.

Booking is via the Visit Us page of our website (www.bronte.org.uk/visit-us) After reading the safety information, you will be directed to Art Tickets where you will be asked to select a date and time and type of ticket. Once you have completed the transaction, your ticket is then emailed to you so you can print it out or download it to a mobile device.

Visitors are also required to wear face coverings. Until restrictions are lifted further, just six people at a time will be admitted at 15 minute intervals. The museum shop is open when the Museum is and screens have been installed at the cash desk and in the shop. Contactless payments are preferred, but we will accept cash where this is not possible. As we were closed for much of last year, our Anne Brontë bicentenary exhibition, 'Amid the brave and strong', is still running and we have two other new exhibitions



to share with you. In the foyer, you will find 'Gondal Arise!', an exhibition of illustrations by Isabel Greenberg depicting maps and scenes from the Brontës' childhood imaginary worlds. Elsewhere in the Museum, you will notice an installation by ceramic artist Layla Khoo. 'Contemplating Hope' is inspired by the diary papers of Emily and Anne Brontë and invites visitors to record their hopes and dreams and post them in one of a series of specially-commissioned ceramic vessels. 'Contemplating Hope' will run until May 2022 and the vessels will be opened and their contents shared in 2025.

Online, our Brontë Lounge events continue, with Heather Clark, author of 'Red Comet: The Short Life and Blazing Art of Sylvia Plath' joining us on 24 June. Also, keep an eye on our Whats On pages for the return of our Brontë Festival of Women's Writing at the end of July - it's going to be a good'un! After months of uncertainty, it's good to be back and we look forward to seeing you soon.
