He has marked GCSE History since 1994 and now marks GCE General Studies and still retains his interest in education. Clive first became involved with the distribution of publications in 2006. At its peak he was regularly delivering 900 + copies of the [Keighley] Target/Advertiser over a large part of Oakworth before the withdrawl of publication in 2012.
