Infusions of orange rind, rose hip and cinnamon with a little honey for added sweetness, to encourage loving and harmonious energies; allspice, lemon-grass, aniseed, lemon, eyebright and

thyme to bring luck and opportunity and peppermint, spearmint and garden mint to draw wealth and abundance. Magical foods for magical beginnings. Instead of perceiving the sleeping earth as a Hadean wilderness, why not utilise the stillness which comes after Christmas to restore balance and harmony to your life? Our bodies hold within the same secret magic as the seeds resting beneath the earth; this time of new beginnings is a time to nourish both body and soul so that a deep inner transformation can take place. Accept the time of year and make the most of it; enjoy the period of waiting that wintertime brings. Go out for a walk, feel the biting wind on your cheek and through your hair, the rosy glow you experience upon return; these are small but real pleasures. HEALTH & WELLBEING

Most of us average Joe's and Josephine's crave to look younger and healthier. This results in the beauty industry making a lot of money out of our

insecurities. No one has yet come up with the elixir of youth or a magic pill that gets rid of wrinkles. However, before you start booking for Botox injections or looking for the best surgeon to give you a facelift, here are some simple life changing steps that you can follow to promote all of the above.

Always, winter or summer, wear a moisturiser on your face with a minimum of factor 15. Preferably higher in the summer months. The most damage to the skin is caused by overexposure to the sun. Often this may not be noticeable until years later when the damage may be irreversible. However, it's never too late to take measures to prevent any further damage.

Drink water, then drink some more.

Water is nature's own magic potion as it acts as a purifier in the body. The more water you drink, the fresher and firmer your skin will be. It's recommended that you drink 2 litres of water every day.

Stop smoking. As well as all the health related risks smoking brings, it also results in premature skin aging... smoking encourages the carbon monoxide levels in the blood to increase. This promotes the formation of age inducing free radicals resulting in wrinkles and sallow unhealthy looking skin.

Cut back on the caffeine. Too much caffeine works as a diuretic which will

result in the skin becoming dry and dehydrated. If you replace your morning coffee with tea you'll half the amount of caffeine you're consuming straight away. Better still replace the tea and coffee you drink during the day with glasses of water and you are really doing your skin a favour. **Cut back on alcohol.** Alcohol causes the skin to dehydrate resulting in older looking skin.


Get plenty of sleep. Sleep is nature's way of renewing the skin and restoring some of the stressful effects of day to day living. Try to aim for at least 7 hours of sleep every night.

Eat plenty of fibre. Fibre helps the body get rid of waste which results in a brighter, clearer complexion. Also fibre rich foods increase the feeling of fullness which in return encourages you to eat less. And most importantly of all, a diet high in fibre greatly reduces the risk of colon cancer, and can help prevent diabetes. Fibre rich foods include: wholemeal bread, porridge, and other whole grains, vegetables and pulses including baked beans.

Finally make sure you **eat a diet rich in Fruit and vegetables.** This can be one of the most potent ways of improving your health and preventing disease. Daily recommendations are to eat up to 7 portions a day.

Top tip: make your own soups and stews which can be made in bulk and frozen. My favourite is chicken and vegetable soup made from simmering a left over chicken carcass and adding lots of vegetables, some pulses and a stock cube and cooking for a further hour. It's really very tasty and very nutritious.

GARDENER'S TIPS

BY MIKE CUNNINGHAM

Every month Mike Cunningham will be sharing his expertise on gardening and plant care. Mike is the Chair of

Keighley in Bloom and helps organise the annual Keighley Horticultural Show on Keighley Show day. Mike is a national Dahlia judge. He has had a successful 2006, winning several first prizes and a handful of silver and bronze medals at both local and national shows.

JOBS OF THE MONTH - JANUARY

January is usually considered to be the month for plants in the greenhouse. Yet outside, snowdrops are beginning to show and the autumn shrubs such as Viburnum and Jasmine are still in mid-winter flower.

Bulbs:

Start to bring potted and covered narcissi and hyacinths indoors to slowly warm up.

Fruit:

Weather permitting plant new fruit trees and bushes. Prune existing stock.

House Plants:

Don't over water those Christmas gifts, but avoid dry atmosphere and give them light.

Lawns:

Trim and repair edges, etc. An early first cut may be feasible, but remember to lift cutting blades to their highest setting.

Roses:

You can plant new roses if the soil is dry or moist, but not if it's wet and heavy or if there's frost or a covering of snow.

Patios and Town Gardens:

Move container pots to a sheltered position or protect with fleece. Remove moss etc. from stonework and flags, (I use a power spray, they can be hired for less than £10 per day).

Miscellaneous:

Order flower and vegetable seeds, gladioli and onion sets. Get mowers and garden equipment serviced now; don't wait until spring or you'll be in a long queue. Wash/disinfect (mild solution Jeyes fluid) greenhouse glass, plastic pots/trays. Check and repair wooden structures if necessary.

Who's Who on the Street ?

You may have heard the terms 'Emo' and 'Chav' before, but do you really know what they mean? I felt that the lack of awareness had gone too far when my mother referred to an 'Emo' as an 'emu'! So study up, and you'll really impress your kids and grandchildren when you next walk down the high street.

CHAV

First, there's the 'Chav', a common term describing a style of music, fashion and teen behaviour. Chavs can also be known as Scallies, NEDs (Non-educated-delinquents), Townies, Mal-lies and Burbs. The stereotypical Chav would have a Burberry cap, 'bling' (often large, gold jewellery), tracksuit bottoms (often tucked into their socks), white branded trainers and other branded sportswear. 'Chavy' music is club dance, electronic and DJ mixes.

With all that sportswear on, you'd have thought that Chavs take part in a lot of sports, but think again. The tracksuits and trainers are more of a fashion statement than practical clothing. Instead, Chavs are generally found hanging around on the streets, often loud and rowdy and sometimes up for causing trouble.

EMO

'Emo' is another commonly used term describing a way of dressing, a style of music and behaviour. There are different ideas about its origins. Many think that it simply stands for 'emotional' whereas others believe it comes from the styles of music known as 'emotive-hardcore' or 'Emo-core'.

Emos have a definite style of their own - often dyed black hair (in either side swept fringe or straight bar fringe), skinny jeans (mostly black but sometimes bright crazy patterns), studded belt, lots of stripes or polka-dots, band t-shirts and thick black horn-rimmed glasses.

'Emo-hardcore' is the type of music from which the Emo style was built, some of it more tame but some basically 'hardcore screaming'.

Emos are usually portrayed as depressed, self-hating and unhappy.

They are usually at a computer, on the phone, hanging around or at a gig of some sort. The Corn-Exchange in Leeds has become a meeting place for Emos from the surrounding areas at the weekend.

'GOTH'

This is a term that has been frequently used for the past 30 years. Goths also have a certain style of music, fashion and behaviour associated with dark, heavy music and unusual clothing. Lots of people could probably point out a Goth, but just in case, here is an explanation...

Goths are usually into metal, rock and alternative styles of music. They also have a unique appearance. Their clothes are often black and very expressive - Goth boots, corsets and baggy jeans. Goths usually have a lot of piercing on their face and body. The



best way to explain what a Goth looks like is to show you one, so I found a picture of a stereotypical Goth.

MOSHER

'Moshers' is a fairly new term. It comes from a style of dancing (or 'mashing') which basically involves throwing yourself and others around with 'head-banging' and 'body-slamming' combined into a form of dancing. That is if you class 360° kicks and crowd surfing as dancing...

Moshers are into a similar style of music as Goths, Punks and Emos and are generally happy with any music with a thick baseline and heavy drums.

The Moshers fashion style generally includes band t-shirts, baggy jeans and hoodies, and they are often mistaken for Punks, Emos or Goths. They like nothing better than going out to a gig, getting drunk and throwing themselves into people and objects. They love the sort of loud music they

can 'head-bang' to and love dancing with their friends.

There are loads of different stereotypes, but these descriptions are the extremes of each category. Just because somebody likes the 'Emo' fashion style, it doesn't mean they are depressed; and if somebody wears Burberry, it doesn't necessarily mean they are a 'Chav'. Also, people don't always fit into only one category. For example, someone who liked the Gothic fashion and music but also liked to 'mosh' would therefore be a 'Moth'! You must also remember that teenagers don't always like being 'classified', so just make sure that as you're walking down the street past a Chav you don't say very loudly to your teenage son or daughter 'Is that a Chav then?' 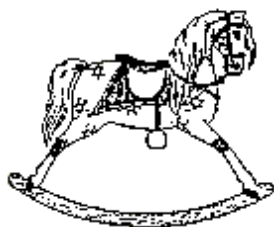

RESTAURANT REVIEW



I'll be honest – I went to Alfe's with a certain air of

scepticism. Was it the traditionally British name, which seemed inappropriate for an exclusive Thai and Chinese restaurant that I found confusing? I didn't know what to expect. I love Thai food and I like to think that I know the authentic thing from gimmicky impostors.

From the minute we walked into the restaurant I was

impressed. The minimalist, sleek, attractive interior; the chilled atmosphere; the enticing smell of Oriental spices; the personal



welcome from Al, the owner. All this combined to raise my expectation of a quality night out.

Alfe's is beautifully designed. The attention to detail is stunning. Small halogen lights inset into a black section of the ceiling spell out the name 'Alfe's'. A thoughtful arrangement of tables allows you to feel your privacy isn't compromised and original artwork for sale on the walls provides interest and class. Mosaic tiled alcoves showcase tasteful vases and ornaments. The table place settings are skilfully laid and help create the overall impression of quality.

With everything so far feeling so right I was convinced that the food would also be excellent – and I wasn't wrong. My friend

chose a dish from the 'a la carte' menu which came beautifully presented and I opted for the 'all you can eat' buffet for £8. I started with the soup, delicate and full of flavour, with shredded chicken and vegetables and also managed to sample the sesame prawn toast, satay chicken on skewers, spare ribs and deep fried wafer wrapped chicken - all absolutely superb. The main dishes were just as good. The Mushroom Thai Curry was the highlight of

my evening (I hope my friends keep it a secret how many helpings I went back for!) I loved the beef with green peppers in black bean sauce and also the Thai sweet and sour chicken. The beef noodles in hot Thai sauce were really something else and the yellow rice was perfect.

There was ample choice and all the dishes I had really were exceptional. Nothing was bland or predictable, as can sometimes be a downfall with Chinese food; each dish had a distinct, individual flavour. I finished off with ice-cream and washed it all down with a rather nice wine. I am certainly looking forward to my next



visit to Alfe's. I've long since forgotten my preconceptions about the name - this restaurant is as authentic as they come. It's stylish surroundings, relaxed atmosphere and first

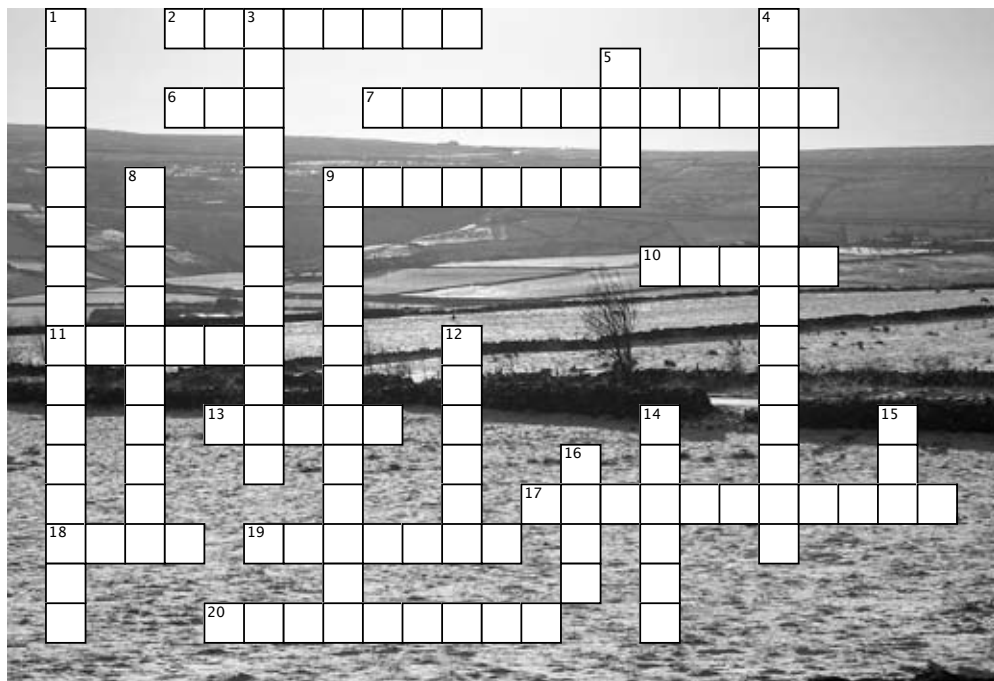
class food make for a really special night out.

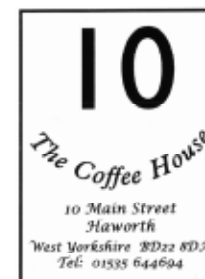

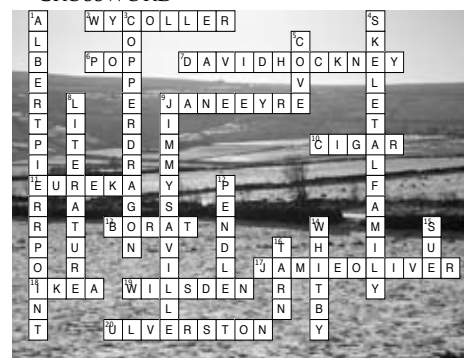
