TOP TECHIE TIPS

Judging by the small mountain of conventional cathode ray tubes at the recycling centre when I went to drop off all the Christmas cardboard, I would say Santa probably delivered quite a lot of HD TV's in December, so to start things off I am going to take a look at how to get more out of a new television with a media center PC.

On the back of almost every flat panel TV is a socket normally marked PC, which means the new monster in the corner of you living room can double as the world's biggest computer monitor. Once you get over the wow factor of seeing such a big clear picture of your desktop there is a whole new set of possibilities to explore.

Starting with the basics, if you use your computer for games, then playing them on such a big screen makes for a much more intense experience, but that's only the start. You can browse the Internet from your armchair. More significantly, you can view all the TV catch-up sites such as BBC iplayer, which has a high quality setting that gives excellent picture quality even on 50" screen.

There are also a myriad of sites to download other content from but those with iPods should be familiar with iTunes and the Apple iTunes Store where it is now possible to purchase or rent movies and TV shows legally. A new release costs about £3.50 to rent and can start playing in fantastic quality a few minutes after you start to download it.

These things are all possible on a standard Mac or PC but if you want to be able to record and pause live TV then you will need to add either a TV tuner card or box that you will plug your aerial into. This means that your computer can pick up FreeView TV and function like a Sky+ box except without the monthly fee. Recordings can be archived, burnt to dvd or scaled down to view on your iPod or phone...the possibilities are almost endless!

So what equipment do you need? If you are a PC user then you can use a box standard machine and do the basics like browse the internet. and play DVDs. If you want a more integrated experience you will need to look at a purpose built media center machine with either Windows XP media center edition or more likely Vista Home Premium installed. These have the media center software in which integrates all the video and audio functions in a single package and start at around £450. They normallly have the tv tuner card built in and should have digital audio output to make it easier to connect surround sound audio to a home cinema system.

For the Mac fans out there the Mac mini is a great solution for £390. It has software called Frontrow which lets you access all the video, photos and music on your system using a cool little remote that comes with it. You'll need to spend another £40 on an Eye TV USB tuner stick which comes with really great software to watch, record and export TV in loads of different formats.





This is a tasty soup (a meal in a cup really) to beat the credit crunch and bring comfort to the darkest winter day. You can pack it as full of as many vegetables as you like (great for using up the last bits from the veg-box) – and it's all done in the microwave, so even a novice cook has no excuse not to try it! Once you've chopped the vegetables and popped them in the microwave, you can leave them for 20 minutes and get on with other things while they cook.

- 1 small onion
- 1 small red or green pepper
- 1 clove of garlic (or as much as you like)
- 1 tablespoon of butter or oil
- 2 medium potatoes (or a largish sweet potato) peeled and chopped into 1cm / ½ inch cubes

800ml stock (use 2 chicken or vegetable stock cubes in 800ml boiling water) 340g sweetcorn (a large can or frozen; creamed sweetcorn is good too.) black pepper

200 ml (small tub) of double cream or crème fraiche

fresh parsley or other herbs to garnish

The secret of this is to chop everything quite small – just one good sharp professional chef's knife is always a sound investment for any kitchen. A quality food-chopper will do the job just as well for those of you who have to look away when Jamie, Gordon and the rest of the TV chefs do their high-speed chopping with big Japanese Santoku knives!

1. Chop onion and pepper well, crush or chop the garlic and put into a microwaveable bowl or jug with the butter or oil

2.Cover and microwave on HIGH for $1\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 minutes

3.Add potatoes, stock, corn and a pinch of ground black pepper


4.Cover and microwave on HIGH for 20 minutes until the potatoes are tender **5.**Stir in the cream or crème fraiche

Delicious topped with a sprinkling of fresh chopped parsley and served in a big soup cup with a side helping of spicy crispy potato wedges or a cheesy muffin or scone.

Serves 4 – 6, or just halve the ingredients for two of you.

Once you've tried the basic recipe, why not make it your own by adding in other finely chopped vegetables to the first step, such as squash, pumpkin, broccoli, courgette, carrot, or swede - or add finely chopped streaky bacon and when cooked, top with crumbled crispy bacon. You could make it into a more substantial meal by adding diced chicken or turkey along with the potatoes and corn. Let me know your favourite combination and I'll share it on my recipe club pages at

"The first season, Christmas 2007, was hard, and a year on, it is still hard

work...but now we have guests returning for their second visit to see the snow-covered peaks and crystal-blue skies. I'm integrating well into the mountain community and

Francis, still living in Yorkshire, comes out regularly."
The most recent development at Haus Hislop has been the availability of the luxury Penthouse. The four bedroom/two bathroom apartment sleeps up to 10 and has outstanding views of the mountains and the use of two private balconies.
